What is this program ?

Come study abroad for a **3-5 week observership** at a partner university teaching hospital tailored to your specific interests.

Upon arrival you will have a **7-day Orientation** including a course in comparative healthcare practices, visits to hospitals/clinics and public health related institutions.

Housing is provided at a Student Residence in the Latin Quarter for the full month of June or students may choose to find their own housing.

This program is **limited to 12 students**, so sign up quickly!

Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Approval by your home institution
- ✓ 1st or 2nd year medical, nursing and public health students—priority given to students from partnering American universities
- ✓ At least 4 semesters of college level French

Program Costs

1200€ (with housing); 640€ (without housing).

This cost includes a course in *Medical Terminology*, *Comparative Medical Practices*, visits, observership (min. 3 weeks), local transportation, civil liability and professional insurance. Airfare and food are not included in this price.
