GUIDELINES FOR GRADE CONVERSION

The system of grading equivalency described below is an adaptation of the international standards determined by the Franco-American Commission for Educational Exchange. Please note that the average passing grade to obtain a degree or pass a course is 10 out of 20 in France, and usually 2.0 (C) out of 4.0 in the US.
