



# Housing with MICEFA

We have something for every budget and every student!

## Chambre de Bonne

This is the typical student housing in Paris. Small, room, with shared bathrooms in the hall, created in the former maid's quarters of historic Parisian buildings. You will have the best view of the city! Great for a student budget as **they range from 480€ – 890€ per month** (utilities not included).



## Studio Apartment

For those looking to live alone and wanting a bit more space, a studio apartment is a great option. The whole apartment is contained in one room, which gives it a nice cozy feel. Depending of the size of the studio and the area of Paris, this option **starts at 670€ per month** (utilities not included).



## University Residence

MICEFA has a limited number of places available in student residences. These rooms provide individual, comfortable, furnished accommodations with private bathrooms at an affordable price. **These rooms range from 480€ - 680€ per month.**



## Shared Apartment

“Coloc,” in French, is a great option for students looking to save money by living with other students or friends they met during the intensive session. **These apartments start at 670€ per person per month** (utilities not included). *\*May not be widely available due to COVID.*



## Room in a Family Home

Looking for an authentic immersion experience? Living with a Parisian family is a great way to experience French life and live at a lower cost. Living with a family gives you all the benefits of being with people and the privacy of having your own room. **This option ranges from 600€ - 950€ per month** (meals are extra not included).

## Au Pair Family

Like the family home option, this housing choice will bring you close to a family. For students looking for the most affordable option, this one is for you. **Students are offered (or given a reduced price for) a private room in exchange for helping to look after the family's children!**

# How it works!

## Choosing Your Housing is Simple!

### **Nomination and Acceptance to the MICEFA**

You must first be nominated to the MICEFA through your Study Abroad office at your University. Once you have been accepted by MICEFA, the housing process can begin.

### **Start Thinking About the Housing Options**

Look at the types of housing available and find which housing option will be best for you. The possibilities will depend on your housing budget and realities of Paris. Define your maximum budget per month for rent, including utilities. Decide if you would like to explore housing options through MICEFA or opt for housing outside of MICEFA.

### **MICEFA Contacts You via Email to Talk About Housing**

Your program assistant will contact you via email asking you to give your choice of housing option and your budget. If you have chosen the Au Pair option, MICEFA will put you in contact with the families at this time.

### **Online Interview With MICEFA Staff to Talk About Housing**

During your online interview with MICEFA you can ask questions and finalize the housing option that you are interested in.

### **Arrival in Paris and Settle into Temporary Housing**

Go to your temporary housing (if you have chosen this option through MICEFA). Get to know fellow MICEFA students and finalize your budget and choices before the housing workshops.

### **Housing Workshop at the MICEFA**

Look through the MICEFA housing listing, call landlords and set up visits. During this time MICEFA staff will accompany you.

### **Visit Different Options and Make Your Final Choice**

Go visit at the actual housing option, see if it is what you were expecting and meet the landlord. Make your final housing choice!

8.



### **Move In!**

Move into your new home! MICEFA will be there if you need any help during the exchange. Inform the MICEFA of your housing choice.
